

Spring Coronet AS LX Competitions

Saltatoris Nebularum! This dance competition is open to all, and will probably be sometime after 4th round. Listen for the music or the herald's shout and look for a shady place. The dance is **Villanella**, an Italian balletto by Fabritio Caroso which will prepare you for the sparkly diamonds dance at Diamond Beltaine next month!

Competition One: **Beauty & Knowledge - Iberian Peninsula 722-1492**

The Iberian Peninsula, place of wonder, place of cultures, center of art and science.

Starting with the Battle of Covadanga, 722, until the Reconquista, 1492. You are invited to explore the Arts and Sciences of the myriad cultures, time periods, and the societies that interacted with the Iberian Peninsula during this time to bring more Beauty and Knowledge to the Principality of the Mists.

Competition Two: **Beauty & Knowledge - African Kingdoms 756-1031**

Explore the African Kingdoms, their trade routes and connections with the Caliphate of Cordoba, and the rest of the known world of the time, 756-1031. Delve into the arts and sciences of varied Kingdoms and cultures using research and creativity to bring Beauty and Knowledge to the Mists.

Drop off A & S entries from 8 am to the start of tournaments in the A & S dragon wing.

Judging will begin at Round 1. Entrants to share their entries at afternoon/evening court to Showcase the Arts & Sciences of our Principality (not required to enter competition) - a designee may also share your entry in court JUDGING will be completed by Semi-Finals ***Judges needed*** - Winners of competitions 1&2 will be announced in evening/afternoon court.

The Principality Exchequer is responsible for balancing the Principality checking account and making sure that accurate payments are made for contracts, Non member surcharges, insurance waivers, and expensense necessary for the running of the territory.

The Constable primarily runs gate and makes sure that individuals attending events sign the necessary waivers and pay the expected site fee for the day/weekend. They are also responsible for gathering lost and found for the Principality and making sure that they are made known to the populace so they may reclaim their items.
